Friendship & Other Weapons is an interactive workshop experience that provides an overview of the epidemic of girl bullying in the United States and offers information, strategies, and skills for parents, professionals, and girls on how to effectively handle relational aggression.

The engaging activities in this workshop will help participants consider the importance of fostering individual strengths while also harnessing the power of group support. Strategies for becoming a "(s)hero" before, during, and after incidents of bullying will be discussed, as participants learn that it is never okay to do nothing about bullying. Along with individual and peer supports, this workshop will engage adults and kids in a conversation about how family members can strengthen and fortify one another throughout a bullying crisis.

Friendship & Other Weapons workshops are about breaking the code of silence that governs conflict among girls and creating a safe, open, fun forum in which participants of all ages can talk, listen, and gain new skills for confronting incidents of cruelty disguised as friendship.
